**Teams:** Teams will consist of up to 4 people playing from a single letter tray, against another 4-member team playing from another single letter tray. Teams with less than 4 members may be matched with others to form a full team.


**Game Play:** All participants must follow official Scrabble rules. Tournament play will consist of three, 30-minute games. Each team will have 3 minutes per turn.
